

# Construction Commencement Notice

## NYES Phase I

### PSC Case 19-T-0684

New York Transco anticipates beginning Phase I of site preparation and construction of its New York Energy Solution (NYES) Project on or about **March 2, 2021**.

### Phase I Project Description & Route

- (1) Development and use of two laydown yards in the Towns of Ghent and Claverack;
- (2) Vegetation removal around the existing 115 kV Churchtown Switching Station in the Town of Claverack;
- (2) Construction of a 0.15-mile 115 kV transmission line shoofly ("Churchtown Shoofly")—including three new monopole structures—in the Town of Claverack to bypass the Churchtown Switching Station during construction to avoid extended line outages; and
- (3) Demolition of the existing 115 kV Churchtown Switching Station and rebuild of a new 115 kV switching station in the Town of Claverack, which will be owned by NY Transco.

The map to the right shows the overall Project Route. The Project traverses the towns of Schodack, Stuyvesant, Stockport, Ghent, Claverack, Livingston, Gallatin, Clermont, Milan, Clinton, and Pleasant Valley. Pending regulatory approvals, a second construction commencement notice will be provided prior to the start of Phase II, which includes the transmission line upgrade along the overall Project Route and construction of associated stations.

### Construction Timeline

Construction of Phase I is expected to start on approximately March 2, 2021 and is estimated to be completed (including restoration) 14 months after construction starts. Additional notices will be sent to neighboring landowners and municipalities prior to entering a geographic area.

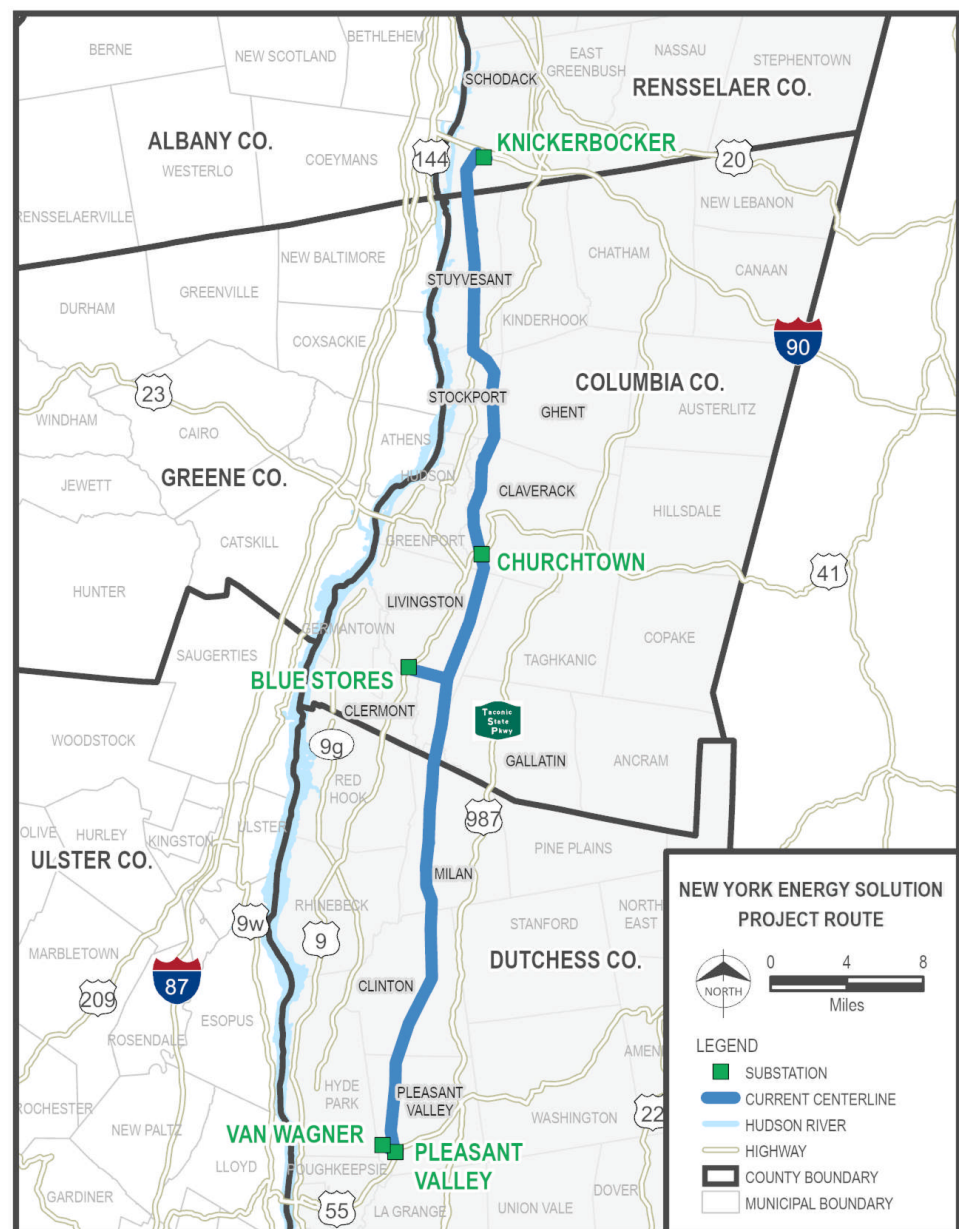
