National Grid Work to Resume New York Energy Solution Corridor North



March 15, 2023

Dear Neighbors,

Please accept this notification that National Grid will soon resume work in portions of the northern (Schodack to Claverack) New York Energy Solution (NYES) corridor. National Grid, the underlying property owner, maintains co-located gas infrastructure assets in the corridor. They will conduct gas line protection and maintenance work related to those assets. The follow are some key details about the upcoming National Grid work that is set to resume:

WHAT:	Gas line protection and maintenance work for an existing underground gas line
WHO:	National Grid & their contractors
WHERE:	Sections of the northern portion of the NYES Corridor (Schodack to Claverack)
WHEN:	The gas work started this past Fall 2022 and will now resume March 2023 through Spring 2023. The work will be intermittent in duration, as well as location.
VEHICLES:	Light duty vehicles will primarily be used by their contractors.
RESTORATION:	Any areas disturbed in the corridor will be restored in a similar manner to what occurred following transmission line work completion. Restoration will occur in Spring 2023.
AGRICULTURAL LANDS:	Any impacted agricultural areas will undergo consultation and restoration, as needed, with the NYES Agricultural Inspector like was done for NYES work.

New York Transco will work with National Grid to ensure the safety of our transmission assets and neighbors, as well as protection of the surrounding lands. *Please note that you may also see separate danger tree work being conducted by New York Transco contractors.*
