NOTICE NO RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ALLOWED IN TRANMISSION CORRIDOR

New York Transco has been encountering a recurring problem with recreational vehicles trespassing on the privately owned New York Energy Solution (NYES) electric transmission corridor, particularly in our southern portion in Dutchess County.

This National Grid-owned property is an active construction site and New York Transco and our contractors working on the NYES project are committed to ensuring the safety of our crews and neighbors, as well as the protection of the surrounding lands.

We are monitoring the corridor with cameras and other security devices for trespassing and recreational vehicle activity. Images and data are transmitted to our team in real-time. Both local and state police are also engaged on the matter. Anyone found to be operating an ATV, UTV, dirt bike or other motorized vehicles in the corridor will be subject to prosecution.
