



Phase II Southern Portion EM&CP Revision

June 11, 2021

Dear Neighbor:

New York Transco submitted the Phase II Southern Portion Environmental Management and Construction Plan (“EM&CP”) Revision for the New York Energy Solution (“NYES”) to the New York Public Service Commission (“PSC”) on or about June 11, 2021, PSC Case #19-T-0684.

What is the Phase II Southern Portion EM&CP Revision?

The plans and specifications for environmental protections and construction of the 345 kV transmission line from the Churchtown Switching Station in Claverack to the terminus at the existing Pleasant Valley Substation; the Blue Stores Tap line in Livingston; and the new Van Wagner Capacitor Bank Station in Pleasant Valley. Construction for this section is planned to begin in fall 2021, pending regulatory approvals.

What was revised?

The Phase II EM&CP was filed with the PSC on February 19, 2021. The June 11th revision updates the southern portion (Claverack to Pleasant Valley) NYES construction drawings, environmental protection plans, and incorporated comments from project stakeholders and State agencies.

Has the PSC approved any EM&CPs for the project?

Yes, the PSC approved the Phase I and Phase II Northern Portion EM&CPs and authorized construction from Schodack to Claverack. Construction has been underway since March 2021 and the Churchtown Shoofly (bypass electric line) has been completed and energized.
