New York Energy Solution Project:

- **In March, we'll celebrate one year of construction by having:**
 - **Erected 27%** of the new monopoles
 - **Energized 23%** of the Project
 - **Built and energized** Churchtown Shoofly bypass line
 - **Completed 76%** of Churchtown Switching Station rebuild
